DECLARATION OF RESERVE NO. 1833
(Your reference: Department No. 226-2019)

I refer to your submission and advise that Her Honour the Administrator has acted with the advice of the Executive Council, given at a meeting on Friday, 20 September 2019, and reserved the unalienated Crown land to be known as Reserve No. 1833 over NT Portion 7495(A), to provide perpetual protection of the verified dolphin habitat.

Schedule

All that area of land and sea in Shoal Bay in the Darwin Region in the Northern Territory of Australia containing an area of 50 hectares or thereabouts and designated Northern Territory Portion 7495(A) and contained within a rectangle commencing at a point bearing 357 degrees 31 minutes and 2324.8 metres from the most western north-western corner of Section 3123, Hundred of Bagot, and thence by lines bearing 270 degrees for 550 metres, 360 degrees for 909.1 metres, 90 degrees for 550 metres and 180 degrees for 909.1 metres to the point of commencement.
